12. **EXECUTIVE SESSION:** An Executive Session was not conducted at this meeting.

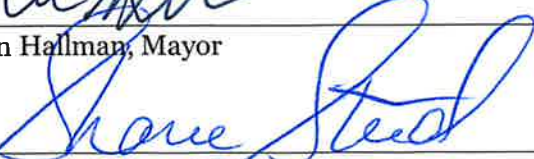
